The Finnladies of Chicagoland's "Kansan Tanhu" has been dancing around Chicago and the Midwest for over forty-years. This ensemble is purely a social phenomenon that performs regularly at Finnish gatherings and holidays, it is rarely seen in public.

Simply translated, "Kansan Tanhu" just means "Folk Dance". The name is clean and pure, like the lakes and forests of Finland. It is a gentle reminder to all Finns of their roots and home. This is traditional stuff...old dances, music, and hand-loomed dresses from small villages around Finland. All of the songs, dances, attire speaks of home. Over the years, the "Tanhu" dancers come and go. This year's dancers at the 2017 IWA Gala include Raisa Matikainen,llona Mansikka, Anne McAlpine, lida Borges, Emma Malloy, Karen Covington, Harris Covington and Sari Covington.

You make a Difference

The George B. Swift School is a K-8th grade school within the Chicago Public School system that serves as a port-of-entry school for low income, immigrant, and refugee students from 55 countries, speaking 65 languages and dialects.

As a result of our successful fund raising efforts, IWA has been able to increase the resources devoted to the students of Swift School.

We fund an 8-week program of coaching and test preparation classes for 5th and 7th graders in addition to funding the skills workshop for all 6th graders and 8th graders preparing to enter high school. We continue our book distribution with Reading is





Fundamental giving over 3,000 books to students over the past several years. We sponsor an annual essay contest for the 4th-8th grades which has been incorporated into their curriculum.

Over the last two years we raised funding for the purchase of much needed



smart white boards for classrooms, musical instruments so Swift School can expand its music program to incorporate a band for the higher grades, in addition to much needed sports equipment.

IWA's volunteer involvement as tutors and mentors provides significant support to the teachers of the school. Our new mentoring program helps students negotiate the labyrinthine process of applying to the

Chicago Public High School system.

Rise in Performance Rating for Swift School

Since 2013 Swift School's performance rating increased to a Level One from Level Two when most CPS school scores decreased due to the new ISAT test. The principal of the school is confident that IWA's involvement has positively affected their performance.

Escaping the Russian Bear

An Estonian Girl's Memoir of Loss and Survival During World War II
by Kristina von Rosenvinge



Kristina von Rosenvinge's mother died in 1940 when two Russian warplanes shot down the unarmed Finnish airliner Kaleva. This unprovoked criminal act occurred in what was technically peacetime, but the fragile relationship between the USSR and Finland, and the occupation of Estonia by the Red Army, prevented further inquiry. All Kristina knew was that her mother would not be coming back. When her father, serving in the German army, died on the Eastern Front, she was adopted by her aunt and uncle. They understood, after the deportations in 1940, that they had to escape occupied Estonia or be destroyed by the Russian Bear. This book is a fascinating and moving account of how the family first masqueraded as Baltic Germans, made their escape, and came back to Estonia, only to have to make another last minute departure on a German troop ship on the last day before the Soviets returned to Estonia. Kristina's family survived the war as it swept through Austria, and the days that followed were dominated by a search for enough food to eat. After winning their struggle for normalcy and stability in Austria, they nevertheless decided to resettle in the United States. Available from Amazon.

Hugo Alvar Henrik Aalto (1898-1976)

A genius, father of Scandinavian modernism, architect, designer and city planner...

As a Finnish architect and designer Alto's work included architecture, furniture, textiles and glassware, as well as sculptures and paintings. He was the first truly humanitarian designer who understood the importance of nature to human beings and whose concern was man and his total environment.

Aalto's creative ideas, designs and philosophy keep on living strongly in numerous architects' and designers' work throughout the world. Frank Gehry, who designed Chicago's Pritzker Pavilion at the Millennium Park, credits Aalto's work for his design inspirations

Aalto was first to make bent wood furniture out of birch plywood. His designs are very simple and it was important for him that they could be easily mass produced.

The image decorating our Suomi Finland 100 Gala invitation and book cover is the aerial view of the world famous Aalto Vase, which has become an internationally known iconic piece of Finnish design. Also known as the Savoy Vase this glassware was inspired by the dress of a Sami woman. Millions have been sold throughout the world, without Aalto ever seeing any proceeds since the rights were sold to someone else.

Aalto means 'a wave' in English and perhaps was partially an inspiration for this vase. He become famous in America after his "Finnish Pavilion" for the New York World Fair won the grand prize in 1938. In the United States there are only a couple of his buildings, one on the MIT campus, where he was a professor of architecture for many years.

If the measure success is what we are leaving behind, then when it comes to Alvar Aalto, he without a doubt succeeded in making a positive lasting impression on this world.
